VOLUNTEER HOURS

VERNON DISTRICT RIDING CLUB is a non-profit organization dependent upon funds raised by various activities including horse shows, clinics, and membership.

- In order to maintain and improve your club facilities, VDRC requires members to participate and volunteer for at least six hours at a horse show, work party, or other task. (Hours may be split.)
- Please submit a separate cheque for your volunteer fee.
- This volunteer fee will be held until **December 31, 2010** and will be refunded to you upon receipt by the VDRC Volunteer Coordinator of the dates, detail of work done and volunteer hours worked (minimum 6 hours total).

Many hands make light work and help spread out tasks amongst all members rather than the shoulders of the same people year after year.

Below are areas where you can help:

EDUCATION

Help to arrange clinics, lectures, demonstrations, etc.

Help to provide information regarding above for advertising.

PHONING

Help with the phoning of members regarding meetings, clinics, work parties, socials etc. as directed by VDRC Executive.

WORK PARTY

Supervise and/or assist at work parties.

Help clean clubhouse.

SHOWS

Manage, organize, or help at the Spring Show, Hunter/Jumper Show, Dressage Rehearsal Day, Dressage Show, or the Annual Open Show.

EQUIPMENT

Help with arranging jumps and dressage equipment as needed for events and storage.

Help with repair and painting of equipment as needed.

Arrange for new jumps to be built as needed.

ADVERTISING

Submit show and clinic dates to horse publications.

Provide newspapers, TV, HCBC with information on shows, events etc. held at the club.

SOCIAL

Arrange for refreshments for AGM and work parties.

At Executive's direction, help to arrange a fundraiser (e.g. Silent Auction, Tack Sale)

At Executive's direction, help to arrange special socials (e.g. Wine and Cheese, Happy Hour)

GROUNDS

Help with miscellaneous ground jobs and repairs.

Help with fence repair and painting.

Arrange shavings delivery and manure removal.

Arrange for pens to be kept clean and in good repair.

Volunteer hour forms will be kept in a binder in the clubhouse. Hours must be signed for by a VDRC Director.
