**SHOWMANSHIP ENGLISH** May be shown in halter or bridle. Only the ability of the showman, to fit and show in a halter class, will be judged. The horse is merely a prop to show the ability of the showman.

**ENGLISH EQUITATION** (Hunt seat on the flat) Class will proceed at least once around the ring at a walk, trot, and canter on command, reverse and repeat. Riders shall then line up on command and execute individual tests at the Judge's discretion.

**Whips are NOT permitted in Hack Classes  
(Pleasure, Show Hack, Road Hack)**

**ROAD HACK** Horses to enter ring at a walk, to be shown at a flat-footed walk, with a reasonably loose rein, trot, strong trot, easy canter, and hand gallop. Only 8 horses to gallop at a time. Judged on performance, conformation, substance and manners.

8. \*Over 14.2 H.H. up to and including 15.3 H.H.
9. \*Over 15.3 H.H. *Campbell-Brown Trophy*
10. STAKE Open to entries who have ridden in class 7, 8, or 9.

**SHOW HACK** To be shown at the walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop. Collected and extended gaits will be called for. To stand quietly. Judged on performance, quality, conformation, and manners. Only 8 horses to gallop at a time.

11. \*15.3 H.H. and under. *Shields Trophy*
12. \*Over 15.3 H.H. *San Pan Memorial*
13. STAKE Open to entries who have ridden in class 11 or 12.

**HUNTER UNDER SADDLE** To be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop both ways of the ring. Only 8 horses to gallop at a time.

14. \*14.2 H.H. and under.
15. \*Over 14.2 H.H. up to and including 15.3 H.H.
16. \*Over 15.3 H.H. *Village Trophy*
17. STAKE Open to entries who have ridden in class 14, 15, or 16.

**The following four classes will be held at approx. 1 p.m. and not necessarily in numerical order with the rest of the day's classes.**

**18a. LEADLINE EQUITATION** (English) Open to riders 2 yrs. old up to and including 6 yrs. old, led by a Senior. May be asked to trot. *Wills Trophy*

**18b. LEADLINE PLEASURE** (English) Open to riders 2 yrs. old and up to and including 6 yrs. old, led by a Senior. May be asked to trot.

**19a. WALK/TROT EQUITATION** (English) Open to beginner riders. Riders are not eligible for any other class under saddle.

**19b. WALK/TROT PLEASURE** (English) Open to beginner riders. Riders are not eligible for any other class under saddle.

**ENGLISH PLEASURE** To be shown at a flat-footed walk, normal trot, and easy canter. NOT TO HAND GALLOP. Medium to light contact to be maintained. Judged on performance, conformation, and manners.

**20. JACK BENNY** (English) Open to riders 39 years and over. To be judged as a Pleasure class.

**21. BIG D ENGLISH PLEASURE FOR VDRC MEMBERS ONLY**

This class, sponsored by *BIG D PRODUCTS*, *CANADA* and *THE PADDOCK*, has been specially created for Vernon District Riding Club members. Prizes will be awarded to 6th place. **To enter you must be a 2010 member of VDRC.**

**22. REQUEST CLASS** (English) Open to horses and ponies who are in their first year of showing under saddle.

**23. MAIDEN ENGLISH PLEASURE** Open to horses and ponies who have never won a first place ribbon in any English Pleasure Division up to the closing date of entries for this show.

**24. \*ENGLISH PLEASURE** 14.2 H.H. and under. *Stead Trophy*

**25. \*ENGLISH PLEASURE** Over 14.2 H.H. up to and including 15.3 H.H. *VDRC Trophy*

**26. \*ENGLISH PLEASURE** Over 15.3 H.H. *Curwen Trophy*

**27. ENGLISH PLEASURE STAKE** Open to entries who have ridden in class 23, 24, 25, or 26.

**WESTERN SHOWMANSHIP AT HALTER** Only the ability of the showman, to fit and show in a halter class, will be judged. The horse is merely a prop to show the ability of the showman.

**31. IN HAND TRAIL** Open to all horses and ponies; cannot be shown in any under saddle class in this show. Judged as a regular trail class with emphasis on ground manners and safety.

**TRAIL HORSE** Judged 100% on manners and performance of horse over obstacles with emphasis on manners, response to the rider, and attitude.

**WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP** Riders will be judged on seat and hands, and ability to control and show a horse. Each rider will be required to work individually. Pattern will be posted one hour before the class commences. The Judge will use individual work to determine the top riders to be called back for rail work.

**WESTERN PLEASURE** Judged on performance, condition, and conformation. Horses must work both ways of the ring at all three gaits. At the discretion of the judge, horses may be asked to extend the walk, jog, or lope one or both ways of the ring. Horses six years old and over must be shown with a bit. Horses five years and under may be shown in a non-mechanical hackamore or a snaffle bit.

**38. MAIDEN WESTERN PLEASURE** Open to horses and ponies who have never won a first place ribbon in any Western Pleasure Division up to the closing date of entries for this show.

**42. STAKE** Open to entries who have ridden in class 38, 39, 40, or 41.

**43. MINIATURE HORSE AND PONY PLEASURE DRIVING** To be shown both ways of the ring at a flat-footed walk, ordinary trot, and strong trot, and to stand quietly. A collected and/or extended trot may be requested. Judged 60% on manners, performance and style, 40% conformation.

**44. MINIATURE HORSE AND PONY DRIVING STAKE** Open to entries who have driven in class 43.

**45. \*WESTERN RIDING HORSE** (Open) Pattern will be posted. Judged on quality of gaits (walk, jog, and lope), flying change of leads, response to rider, manners, disposition, and intelligence. *VDRC Trophy*

**46. \*REINING** (Open) To follow a prescribed course and demonstrate a proficiency in changing leads, turning, spinning, stopping, and backing. NRHA Pattern 1 will be posted.

**47a. LEADLINE EQUITATION** (Western) Open to riders 2 yrs. old and up to and including 6 yrs. old, led by a Senior. May be asked to trot. *VDRC Trophy*

**47b. LEADLINE PLEASURE** (Western) Open to riders 2 yrs. old and up to and including 6 yrs., old, led by a Senior. May be asked to trot.

**48a. WALK/TROT EQUITATION** (Western) Open to beginner riders. Riders are not eligible for any other class under saddle.

**48b. WALK/TROT PLEASURE** (Western) Open to beginner riders. Riders are not eligible for any other class under saddle.

**49. REQUEST CLASS** (Western) Open to horses and ponies who are in their first year of showing under saddle.

**50. JACK BENNY** (Western) Open to riders 39 years and over. To be judged as a Pleasure class.

**51. BIG D WESTERN PLEASURE FOR VDRC MEMBERS ONLY**

**52. TWO-HANDED WESTERN PLEASURE** Open to horses and ponies five years old and under.

**53. PONY WESTERN PLEASURE** 14.2 H.H. and under. *BC Tel Trophy*

**TWO-WAY COMBINATION** Judged as in Western Pleasure first, then change into English equipment and judged as in English Pleasure. Same rider/horse combination throughout. One groom may assist, no wheelbarrows. Competitors have 5 minutes to change over and must remain in the line-up until the 5 minute call.
