STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of the horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

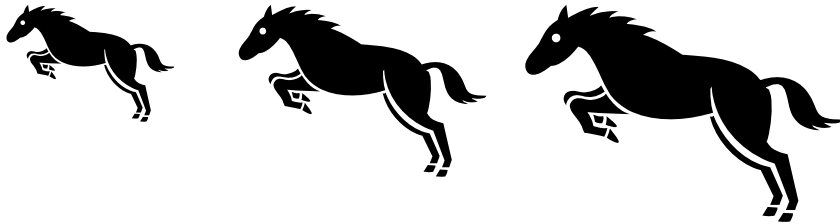

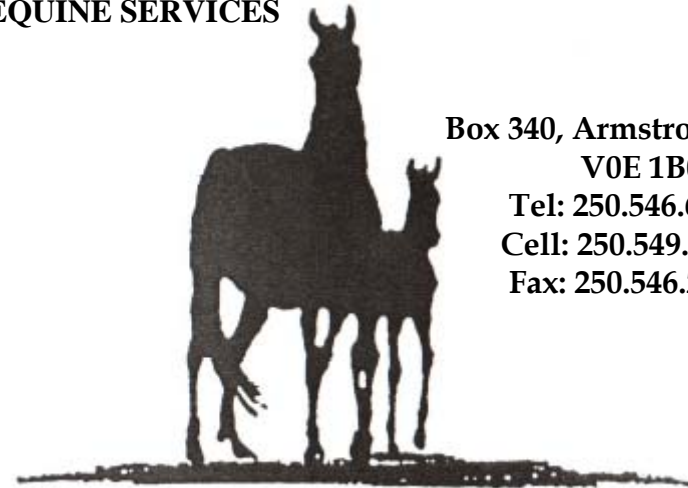

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

BEGINNER HUNTER OR JUMPER RIDERS OR HORSES Must be in their first two years of showing.

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE Judged at the walk, trot, and canter. No more than eight horses at one time may be asked to gallop one way in the ring.

HUNTER OVER FENCES Judged on performance, manners, way of going and hunting soundness.

GREEN JUMPERS Horses must be in their first two years of showing over fences.

EQUITATION OVER FENCES Judged over a course of not less than eight fences. Individual tests may include jumping low fences at walk, trot, or canter; figure of eight at trot demonstrating change of diagonals; figure of eight in canter demonstrating simple change of lead through walk or trot; pull up between fences except in a combination; rein back; additional tests at the judge's discretion.

LEADLINE Riders 2 yrs. of age up to and including 6 yrs. old, led by a Senior. Judged as an equitation class. May be asked to trot.

LEADLINE HUNTER HACK Riders 2 yrs. of age up to and including 6 yrs, led by a Senior. Judged as an equitation class, to trot over two poles.

WALK/TROT Beginner riders only. Judged as an equitation class.

WALK/TROT HUNTER HACK Beginner riders only. Judged as an equitation class, to trot over two poles.

CROSS RAILS HUNTER Judged as a hunter class.

JUMPER If initial round is clear, rider will immediately ride a timed second round.

GREEN JUMPER RIDERS OR HORSES Must be in their first two years of showing over fences.

TABLE A 2.2 A competition against the clock, but in the event of equality of penalties for first place, there will be one jump-off against the clock. Other competitors are placed according to their penalties and time in the first round.

PONY CLASSES Open to ponies 14.2 hh and under.

POWER AND SPEED Classes will be run in two uninterrupted phases with the finish line for the first phase being the start line for the second phase. The first phase is judged under Table A, not against the clock, with a time allowed; the second phase is judged under Table A against the clock. The first phase is a course of eight to nine obstacles with or without combinations. The second phase takes place over four to six obstacles, which may include a single combination. Competitors penalized in the first phase are halted by a bell after they have jumped the last obstacle or when the time allowed for the first phase has been exceeded after crossing the finish line. Competitors not penalized in the first phase will continue the course, which finishes after crossing the second finish line. Competitors are placed according to penalties and time in the second phase. In the event of a tie for first place, a jump-off against the clock over six obstacles of the first and/or second phase may be held.

GAMBLER'S CHOICE The starting line may be crossed in either direction. Each obstacle may be jumped twice, in any order. Obstacles can be jumped in both directions. Points are gathered according to the difficulty of the jump. The Joker is worth 200 points. If the Joker is knocked down, 200 points will be deducted. Ringing of the bell declares the end of the round; 60 seconds are allowed for the round. Time is recorded when the finish line is crossed in either direction; 90 seconds max. time. If by ringing the bell a Joker is required to be jumped within 20 seconds after the fixed time has expired, only one attempt is allowed. Obstacles knocked down will not be rebuilt. No points are gained for a knocked down fence. If a fence is jumped after being knocked down, no points are credited. Refusal does not count as long as the fence remains intact.

VERNON DISTRICT RIDING CLUB GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. **All riders must be Horse Council of B.C. members** and provide proof of current membership. Please send a copy of your membership with your entry form. Passports are not required except for the Dressage Show EC Gold Division.
2. Classes will follow as closely as possible to the attached schedule and will be run at the discretion of the management. The management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes depending on the number of entries received. There must be three or more entries to make a class or to count for aggregates. The management reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and correct any error or omission in the program.
3. Proper headwear, as defined by Equine Canada, is to be worn while riding on the VDRC grounds. A hard hat with secure harness must be worn by anyone riding over fences. Juniors must wear protective headwear at all times when mounted. Boots with proper heels are to be worn at all times when riding anywhere on the grounds. **Riders and handlers must display their numbers at all times.** Any contestant demonstrating unsafe or unsportsmanlike behavior will be disqualified for the remainder of the show without refund of entry fees.
4. Only horses entered in the show will be allowed on the grounds on the day of the show. Stallions are to be handled or ridden by persons 18 years or older. If you are bringing a stallion, please contact show management to make arrangements.
5. Dogs must be kept on leashes and kept in the trailer-parking areas. You are encouraged to leave your dogs at home.
6. Longeing is only allowed in the round pen. Please take turns. In the warm-up ring, take practice fences so that the red flag is on your right. An adult must be in attendance when a junior rider is jumping in the warm-up ring.
7. A veterinary or doctor's certificate is required for a refund of entry fees. The show entry secretary must be notified of a cancellation before the show begins. The administration fee will not be refunded.
8. Drug testing fees will be levied for Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum Shows.
9. Protests or objections will be handled by the management.
10. The management reserves the right to refuse any entry.
11. Riders may ride a maximum of three horses per class.

Division fee: \$45. Open to horses and ponies. No cross entry with classes 26-35. One optional oxer.

Class 5: Low Hunter Over Fences

Class 6: Low Hunter Stake Over Fences

Class 7: Low Hunter Under Saddle

BEGINNER RIDER/LOW HUNTER EQUIT. OVER FENCES

Fences to 2'. Entry fee per class: \$15. Classes may be combined if entries warrant, but will be judged separately. No cross entries with classes 26-35.

Class 8: Beginner Rider Equitation Over Fences

Class 9: Low Hunter Equitation Over Fences

Division C PONY HUNTER Fences 2' to 2'6". May cross enter with classes 1 - 21 or 26 - 35 but not both. Division fee: \$45. Open to all ponies 14.2 hh and under. To be ridden by a Junior rider.

Class 10: Pony Hunter Over Fences

Class 11: Pony Hunter Stake Over Fences

Class 12: Pony Hunter Under Saddle

PONY HUNTER EQUITATION OVER FENCES

Fences 2' to 2'6". Entry fee \$15. May cross enter with classes 1-21 or classes 26-35, but not both.

Class 13: Pony Hunter Equitation Over Fences

TIMBITS Approximately 12:00 Noon

Entry fee \$5.00 per class, admin. fee will apply, no drug fee.

Class 22: Children's Leadline: 6 years and under

Class 23: Children's Leadline Hunter Hack: 6 years and under

Class 24: Walk/Trot: Open to beginner riders, no cross entry with any class other than class 25.

Class 25: Walk/Trot Hunter Hack: Open to beginner riders, no cross entry with any class other than class 24.

Division D SHORT STIRRUP Fences to 2'3".

Division fee: \$45. Open to all horses/ponies and Junior riders. May cross enter with classes 1-21 or classes 26-35, but not both.

Class 14: Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences

Class 15: Short Stirrup Hunter Stake Over Fences

Class 16: Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

Division E LONG STIRRUP Fences to 2'3".

Division fee: \$45. Open to all horses/ponies and Senior riders. May cross enter with classes 1-21 or classes 26-35, but not both.

Class 17: Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences

Class 18: Long Stirrup Hunter Stake Over Fences

Class 19: Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle

SHORT/LONG STIRRUP HUNTER EQUIT. OVER FENCES

Fences to 2'3". Entry fee per class: \$15. Classes may be combined if entries warrant, but will be judged separately. May cross enter with classes 1-21 or classes 26-35, but not both. Open to horses and ponies.

Class 20: Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences

Class 21: Long Stirrup Equitation Over Fences
